Achievement of Sustainable Event Standards Certification

The Events Industry Council (EIC) is pleased to announce that [Resorts World Sentosa \(RWS\)](#), Asia's premium lifestyle destination resort, is the first organization in the world to achieve the Platinum Level certification under the latest 2022 Sustainable Events Standards (Venue) released in June 2022.

The [EIC Sustainable Event Standards](#) (SES) are specific standards for environmental and social responsibility within the events industry. Created by the EIC Sustainability and Social Impact Committee in partnership with industry professionals and leading sustainability practitioners, the requirements provide event planners and suppliers with prescriptive actions for producing and delivering sustainable events. The standard specifies performance criteria in the areas of organizational management, marketing, communications and engagement, climate action, water management, materials and circularity, supply chain management, diversity, equity and inclusion, accessibility, and social impact. The Venue standard is one of eight comprehensive standards for environmentally sustainable events.

With the sector set to have a strong recovery, this is an opportunity to not only entrench our sustainability practices, but to also communicate to our delegates, guests and visitors that RWS is committed to environmentally and socially responsible practices needed to support long-term sustainability in our industry. We are indeed honored to be the first in the world to be certified according to EIC 2022 Sustainable Events Standards platinum level, it validates this commitment and energizes us to take our efforts to the next level."
